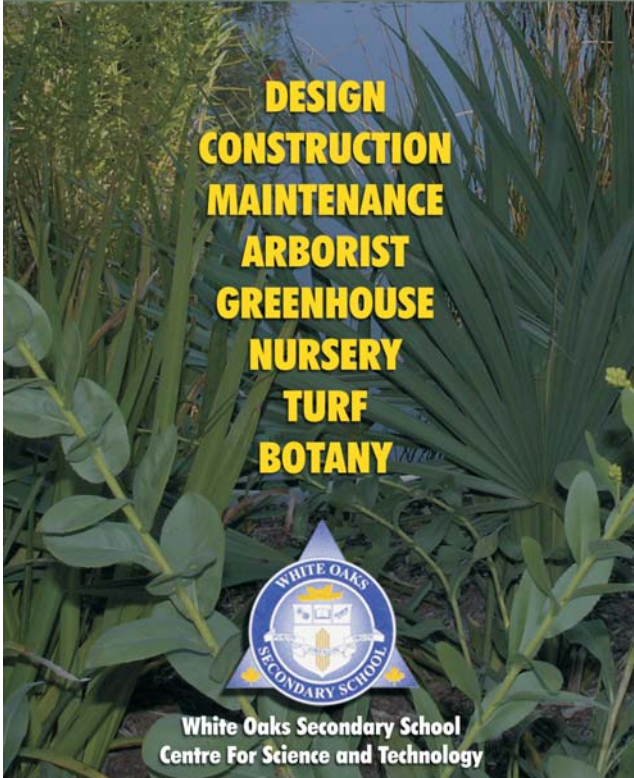

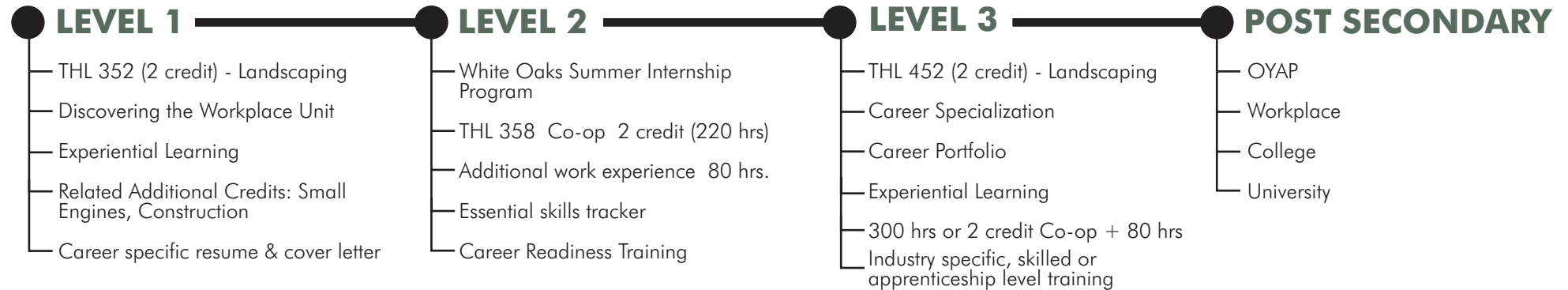

B Application Process

Pre Registration:

Discuss career plans with parents, teachers and/or student services department staff.

Formal application:

Choose HIP Landscaping on the WOSS option sheet or fill in a HIP application found in student services as soon as possible. Have your guidance counselor electronically fill out application and set an interview time on "CHAT".

Information Interview:

Participate in a formal interview designed to gather information about the student and to clarify information regarding this regional program. An introductory letter and resume is required.

C Upon acceptance to the program students will:

- Earn high school credits while working towards a specific career goal
- Work in the Landscaping industry to gain additional work experience during the summer months
- Make a commitment to be consistent in effort and attendance in all courses while in school and on the job
- Continue to post secondary education or work placement within the Landscaping industry after high school
